IT team is working out great with each committee having a representative. Ms Lynn Becker praised Jenna Mailoto's efforts on the RPDI web page.

Ken went over new ASMC award process. The 5 star award application is now completed electronically. The end of April is the due date. Individual awards due by 31 Jan 2010.

The mentorship program is proving successful. Ken is still in the process of matching mentors with new personnel.

Meeting wrapped up with Ken encouraging all to attend General Chedister's presentation on the 15th of Jan at 3PM. He is hoping to have the General present the MAD award to the first recipient.
